	Max score differential in any game is 7										
Tie Breaker (Pool)	Head to head tie-breaker is to be used for TWO TEAM ties only. If 3 or more teams are tied, and if one team has defeated all other tied teams, that team advances. If not, then the first tie-breaking criteria will be the run differential max by all tied teams, then runs allowed by all teams, then runs scored by all teams, then coin flip. With 3 or more tied teams, the criteria never reverts back to the 2 team tie criteria.										
Tie Breaker (Bracket)	International Rules - No outs, runner on 2nd (Last batted out)										
Warm-up Pitches	New Pitcher - 8 pitches, Returning Pitcher - 5 pitches										
Rule Interpretation Protest	\$100 Cash										
Courtesy Runners	A courtesy runner is allowed for pitcher & catcher of record. Available substitute or last batted out.										
Home Team Designation	In pool play, a coin toss will determine the home team. In bracket play, the better seed decides. Home team is keeper of Official Scorebook.										
Home Team Responsibilities	Home team must confirm final score with the base umpire immediately upon completion of the game.										
Required baseballs for play	Each team will provide 2 new baseballs for each game. If additional balls are required due to balls going out of play, the team at bat must supply the additional balls.										
Final Score Confirmation	All Managers/Head Coaches must meet with the Base umpire immediately after the game to confirm score.										
	If a game is cancelled due to weather: 5U-12U, 3 innings (2.5 with home team leading) is a complete game. 13u-14U (3.5 with home team leading) is a complete game.										
Rain-Out Policy	If a tournament is rained out during bracket play, and if everyone has NOT completed the first game of bracket play, then seeding is the determining factor.										
	If a tournament is rained out during bracket play, and if everyone has completed at least 1 game of bracket play, then it goes to record, run differential, runs against in bracket play only. A team that receives a bye in any round receives a winning score of 7-0 for that round.										
Rain-Delay Policy	Once a game is an Official Game, there is a 45 min window to resume the game. After 45 minutes, the game is Final.										
Umpire Ejections	The ejected party must leave the park immediately and may not return to the park for the remainder of that day only. If the ejected party does not leave accordingly, that person's team will be disqualified.										
Fighting	Fighting will result in immediate ejection.										
Forfeits	Forfeits are scored as 7-0.
