Bat Size	The catcher is required to wear a NOCSAE approved helmet/mask, chest guard, shin guards, and protective cup										
Slung Bat	1.15 Stamp required - NO 2 3/4 DeMarini CF Zen-CBZ 17 Model (-10) or 2 5/8 DeMarini CF Zen (-8)										BBCOR -3 or Wood
Head First Slide	1 Warning per player, then player out										
Bucket Seat/Bench	Legal if No: Face Mask, C-Flap, or Chin Strap										
Pitching Limit	No buckets on field or other stools										
Defensive Visits	None - Coaches Protect Your Pitcher										
Pitcher	3 visits allowed per game.										
Courtesy Runner	Removed once per inning. Must stay in lineup.										
Batting Order DH or EH	Last Batted Out if CBO for pitcher and/or catcher; eligible subs if traditional lineup										
Start <9 Players	Coach Discretion										
Tie Breaker (Pool)	Must start with 9, can finish with 8										
Tie Breaker (Bracket)	Record, Head to Head, Runs Allowed, Runs Scored, Coin Flip										
Rule Interpretation Protest	California rules- 1 out, runner on second (last batted out)										
Courtesy Runners	\$100 Cash										
Home Team Designation	A courtesy runner is allowed for pitcher & catcher of record. Available substitute or last batted out.										
Home Team Responsibilities	In pool play, a coin toss will determine the home team. In bracket play, the better seed decides. Home team is keeper of Official Scorebook.										
Away Team Responsibilities	Home team must confirm final score with the base umpire immediately upon completion of the game.										
Required baseballs for play	Away team must run the scoreboard										
Final Score Confirmation	Each team will provide 2 new baseballs for each game. If additional balls are required due to balls going out of play, the team at bat must supply the additional balls.										
Rain-Out Policy	All Managers/Head Coaches must meet with the Base umpire immediately after the game to confirm score.										
	If a game is cancelled due to weather: 5U-12U, 3 innings (2.5 with home team leading) is a complete game. 13u-14U 4 innings (3.5 with home team leading) is a complete game.										
	If a tournament is rained out during bracket play, and if everyone has NOT completed the first game of bracket play, then seeding is the determining factor.										
	If a tournament is rained out during bracket play, and if everyone has completed at least 1 game of bracket play, then it goes to record, runs allowed, runs scored in bracket play only. A team that receives a bye in any round receives a winning score of 7-0 for that round.										
Rain-Delay Policy	Once a game is an Official Game, there is a 45 min window to resume the game. After 45 minutes, the game is Final.										
Umpire Ejections	The ejected party must leave the park immediately and may not return to the park for the remainder of that day only. If the ejected party does not leave accordingly, that person's team will be disqualified.										
Fighting	Fighting will result in immediate ejection.										
Forfeits	Forfeits are scored as 7-0.
